Lompoc Mobile Library Hosts Valentine's-Themed Pop-Up Storytime Preschool-aged children are invited to a bookmobile stop with storytime and Valentine's - themed craft

LOMPOC, CA, Jan. 25, 2017 – Charlotte's Web Mobile Children's Library, part of the Lompoc Public Library System, is offering a Valentine's-themed storytime at Ryon Park for preschool-aged children.

Preschool-aged children and their families are invited to grab a blanket and join us for some fun at **10 a.m.** on **Sat. Feb. 11**. Valentine's Day-themed stories will be told starting at 10 a.m. with a craft related to the story following.

All ages are welcome. However, children must be accompanied by an adult. Materials for the craft will be provided to participants for free.

The bookmobile will be open for visitors immediately after the storytime and craft, and will remain open until noon. All books and materials checked out from the bookmobile can be returned to any Black Gold library. In addition, library staff will be able to issue new library cards for adults and children who have a guardian present, along with identification and proof of address.

Story time in the park is weather permitting, and will be cancelled in the event of rain.

In addition, the bookmobile will be parked outside of the City of Lompoc Recreation Division's Father Daughter Dance on Fri. Feb. 10 at the Anderson Recreation Center.
