Lompoc Fire Department To Host Junior Fire Camp *Program provides local youth with hands-on learning experience*

LOMPOC, CA, June 9, 2017 – The Lompoc Fire Department, in partnership with Lompoc Parks and Recreation, will again be hosting Junior Fire Camp. Camp will run June 12 through June 15, 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. each day. This popular program that offers local youth a chance to experience the firefighting profession first-hand is in its 19th year.

Junior Fire Camp is open to children ages 7 to 10 years old. Junior Fire Camp participants will take part in a hands on learning experience exploring what is involved in the life and work of a firefighter.

Junior Fire Camp will be held at Fire Station #1, 115 South G. St. in Lompoc.

This program is a great opportunity for children to become educated on fire safety, as well as what it takes to become a firefighter. Fire Camp's activities include: the aerial ladder climb, tower repel, rescue searches, extinguishment of fires, fire hose challenges, and bucket brigade, among others.
