LOMPOC FIREFIGHTERS BEGIN TRAINING ON NEW RIC PACKS

Lompoc, CA, Sept. 11, 2017 – Today, members of the Lompoc Fire Department began in-service training on four new Rapid Intervention Crew (RIC) Packs. Each RIC pack offers a small, lightweight, and compact solution for rapid entry and air replenishment to a firefighter, or victim, in distress during a fire or hazardous atmosphere. The new equipment will be placed on all frontline fire apparatus within the City.

All four RIC Packs were secured by the Lompoc Firefighters Foundation via a previously secured \$25,000 grant from the Hutton Parker Foundation earlier this year. This grant enhanced core support equipment for the Lompoc Fire Department. This vital equipment is directly related to each member's safety, and the Department's overall mission and commitment to providing service to the community.

Founded in 2005, the Lompoc Firefighters Foundation is a non-profit organization created to raise money for equipment needs to assist firefighters in service to the community.
