### **Lompoc City Manager Announces Resignation**

*Patrick Wiemiller has accepted a position with the City of Santa Maria*

**LOMPOC, CA, Nov. 9, 2017** – Lompoc City Manager Patrick Wiemiller today announced his resignation as City Manager for the City of Lompoc.

Wiemiller has given 90 days notice of his resignation to Lompoc City Council in accordance with his employment agreement. Details of his resignation are being worked out, including his final day of employment with the City of Lompoc and who will serve as Interim City Manager for the City of Lompoc while city council hires a permanent city manager.

Wiemiller has accepted a position as Assistant City Manager for the City of Santa Maria.

During Wiemiller's four years in the role of City Manager for the City of Lompoc, retail growth in the city has consistently outpaced the State of California as a whole, and the city police and fire departments have made strides in improving service and community outreach.

"I am grateful for the opportunity to have served a wonderful community in a city which I am blessed to not only have worked in, but also call my home," Wiemiller said. "My wife Cindy and I have made many friends here in Lompoc, and we will continue to be a part of, and invest in, the Lompoc community."

### **City of Lompoc**

The City of Lompoc was founded as a town in 1874 and incorporated as a city on Aug. 13, 1888. Prior to the City's establishment, the building of La Purisima Mission in 1787 marked the earliest European settlement in the Lompoc Valley. Growth in the Lompoc Valley was sparked by the 1901 completion of the coastal railroad between San Francisco and Los Angeles, which included the extension of a spur into Lompoc. The Lompoc Valley is home to Vandenberg Air Force Base, the first missile base of the United States Air Force. Today, the City of Lompoc is a travel destination known for its downtown mural program, local wines and acclaimed cuisine, historic landmarks, parks and nearby beaches. For more information, visit:
