Lompoc Library Bingo Challenges Community To Read, Connect, Discover *Bingo cards available throughout the month of March*

LOMPOC, CA, Feb. 28, 2018 – The Lompoc Public Library will be challenging community members as part of a Bingo game to **Read** in a variety of formats and genres, **Connect** with other community members and **Discover** new experiences and community places.

Library Bingo cards will be available for free at the library March 1 through 31. Participants must complete activities in five consecutive squares for a “Bingo”, and are then asked to answer a brief, optional survey on the back of the card. The game is for adults, and activities include reading newspapers and books, and trying new foods, among other ways to read, connect and discover.

Participants must return Bingo cards to the Lompoc Library for a ticket into a prize drawing that will be held on April 2. Prizes include three gift certificates to local businesses. Entrants need not be present to win.

Library Bingo cards are available in English and Spanish.
