Residents of Vandenberg Village, Mission Hills, and Mesa Oaks are eligible to receive a no-charge service of the Village Library when they are ill, disabled, or unable to visit the library for any health-related reason. Call the library, 733-3323, and request this service by leaving your name and your telephone number. Volunteers will call and arrange a visit with you to explain the service and help you obtain the library materials you would enjoy. This is an ongoing service for the length of time you have the need.

The Village Library has a comprehensive collection, and materials are also available from other libraries through the Black Gold System. The volunteers can order these for you. Books – hard cover, paperback, and large print – are in both the fiction and non-fiction stacks. For those who prefer a wider media approach, there are audio books on cassette and CD, and movies on DVD and VHS. Magazines can be checked out, and many young adult, children's and junior picture books are also on the shelves. The volunteers can also help in ordering free Braille audio materials.
