
Regarding Subway 1206 West Ocean

The city has already given the waiver to other restaurants in Lompoc.

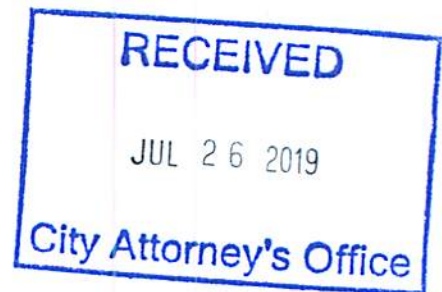

**RULING ON REQUEST FOR RECONSIDERATION**

Dear Ms. Becerra:

I have received and reviewed your request for reconsideration dated June 18, 2019 submitted on behalf of the Subway Sandwich Store (Subway Store) located at 1206 West Ocean Avenue.

The Lompoc Municipal Code (LMC) allows the Utility Director the discretion to determine whether traps/interceptors to capture grease are required in restaurants and other businesses in order to protect the City's wastewater system. (LMC 13.16.370) I have reviewed the information you provided and found it does not negate the need for a grease trap to be installed at the Subway Store.

For that reason, your request for reconsideration is denied.

You may appeal my ruling to the City Council by submitting a written appeal to the City Clerk within 10 working days. That appeal shall be heard and decided by the City Council at a regular City Council meeting held within 60 days after receipt of your request. (LMC 13.16.140)
