Recommendation: Council adopt Resolution No. 6724(24), to authorize budget appropriations of \$50,000 to support the initial six months of administrative and operational needs of a proposed Vandenberg Community Consortium (VCC), approve the recruitment process for a Non-Represented Part-Time General Executive/Professional as a City employee to lead the VCC, and authorize the City Manager to execute any documents related to the establishment of the VCC; and receive and review the Draft Bylaws for the VCC as a proposed guiding document for its governance and operations. Revenues are estimated to offset up to 80% of the VCC's budget, reducing the net impact on City resources.
