Acting City Manager Police Chief Kevin Martin provided a brief presentation on events and happenings in the City, which includes **Adulting 101** and **Tech 101** workshops and the **Annual Peeps Diorama Contest**, all being held at the Lompoc Public Library; the opening of registration for the City's **Annual Mother-Son Luau** which is scheduled for Friday May 2, and Saturday May 3 at the Anderson Recreation Center; the youth track and field meet scheduled for Sunday April 27, at Huyck Stadium and hosted by the City Recreation Division and Lompoc Kiwanis; the Solid Waste and Urban Forestry Divisions giveaway of mulch and compost on Saturday, April 5 at 1300 West Laurel Avenue; the Lompoc Fire Department's newly hired and newly promoted Fire Department members and an updated **Fire Hazard Severity Map** was released by CAL FIRE; the Lompoc Police Department hosted its 2nd Annual Evening of Honor in which the Police Chief highlights efforts and achievements of Police Department staff members and volunteers; and extended a thank you from the entire City to Community Development Director Christie Alarcon who has accepted another position outside the City and her last day here in the City will be April 2, 2025.

5. **Introduction of Ordinance No. 1725(25) Amending Chapter 8.04 of the Lompoc Municipal Code to Regulate City Use of Compost and Mulch and Procurement of Recovered Organic Waste Products, as Required by State Law.**

Introduced, for first reading by title only with further reading waived, Ordinance No. 1725(25), amending Chapter 8.04 of the Lompoc Municipal Code, which regulates City use of compost and mulch and procurement of recovered organic waste products.

6. **Award and Approval of Hazardous Waste Professional Services Agreement with Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc.**

Awarded the Professional Services Agreement (Agreement) to Clean Harbors Environmental Services, Inc. (Clean Harbors), the lowest cost and most responsive bidder to Request for Proposal No. 3079 to provide hazardous waste transportation, disposal, and related services for Lompoc's hazardous waste collection programs, for a total compensation not to exceed \$400,000; approve and authorize the City Manager to execute the Agreement; authorize the Purchasing and Materials Manager to issue a Contract Purchase Order in the amount not to exceed \$400,000. The term of the Agreement will be for three years, including two additional one-year options to extend the Agreement; and authorize the City Manager to approve two additional one-year optional extensions and pricing adjustments pursuant to the Agreement.

ACTION: Motion/Second: Starbuck/Bridge. By a 5-0 vote, Council appointed Carlo DeLa Fuente to the Airport Commission with a term ending January 31, 2027.

8. Consideration of Letter from Voces Sin Fronteras Lompoc.

Jeff Malawy, City Attorney presented the Staff report and requested Council provide direction on this matter.

Council thanked Staff for the information and briefly discussed the matter.

Public Comment:

1. Robin Dunaetz, Daisy (Unknown last name), Mary (Unknown last name), Christina Valdez, Darlene (Unknown last name), Sabrina Ross, Grace (Unknown last name), Larissa Hilario, Alex Ferguson, (First name unknown) Buchanan, and 20 persons who did not provide a name, spoke in favor of the requests provided to Council in their letter dated February 28, 2025 and asked Council to provide a written formal public item which supports undocumented citizens and a City Resolution stating the City will do all it can to protect the rights and privacy of undocumented residents.
2. 2 persons who did not provide a name spoke against the requests from Voces Sin Fronteras Lompoc.

The Council continued to discuss this matter at length.

ACTION: Motion/Second: Bridge/Vega. By a 5-0 vote, Council considered the letter dated February 28, 2025, from Voces Sin Fronteras Lompoc and directed Staff to return with a City Resolution expressing support for undocumented residents of Lompoc.
