

RESOLUTION NO. 6757(25)

**A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Lompoc,
County of Santa Barbara, State of California,
Approving the Annual Operations and Maintenance Plan and
Authorizing Submittal of the Notice of Exemption to the
Santa Barbara County Clerk of the Board**

WHEREAS, the Annual Operations and Maintenance Plan (AMP) for Fiscal Year 2025-26, attached hereto as Exhibit A, was prepared as a tool to eliminate repetitious environmental documentation of operations and maintenance activities considered routine that will not have a significant impact on the environment; and

WHEREAS, Section 21084 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) creates Categorical Exemptions and the adopted CEQA Guidelines indicate that operations, maintenance, and replacement activities are considered to be exempt; and

WHEREAS, those routine maintenance activities included in the AMP that take place during City of Lompoc's operations have been reviewed and determined to fit into the above classifications pursuant to the CEQA Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, A Notice of Exemption has been prepared for submission to the Santa Barbara County Clerk of the Board for activities listed in the AMP.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Based upon the above-described information, there is no substantial evidence the adoption of the AMP will have a significant effect upon the environment.

SECTION 2. The AMP attached hereto as Exhibit A is hereby adopted.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is effective upon its adoption.
