

Ordinance No. 1729(25)

**An Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Lompoc,
County of Santa Barbara, State of California,
Designating Fire Hazard Safety Zones**

WHEREAS, the State Fire Marshal is mandated by Government Code section 51178 to identify levels of fire hazard based on consistent statewide criteria and the expected severity of fire hazards; and

WHEREAS, Government Code section 51179 requires the State Fire Marshal to make recommendations of fire hazard severity zones to local agencies, as defined per Government Code section 551177(e), for their designation and adoption by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the State Fire Marshal has provided the Local Responsibility Area Fire Hazard Severity Zones identified in Exhibit A attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the State Fire Marshal identified the City of Lompoc as having Moderate, High, Very High, or a combination of Fire Hazard Safety Zones as indicated on Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Local Responsibility Area Fire Hazard Severity Zones identified in Exhibit A attached hereto are hereby adopted as required by Government Code section 51179. The maps and data are available in the FHSZ HUB at <https://fire-hazard-severity-zones-rollout-calfire-forestry.hub.arcgis.com/>.

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days after its adoption.
