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SUBJECT: Divisional Update - June/July 2025

Updates for 2025FY:

- Water Division Cross-Connection Control Plan (CCCP) received final approval from the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB). The plan is to be implemented by a 3rd party contracted service while staff completes the job specification approval for the full-time permanent position within the Water Division as a Regulatory Compliance Specialist.
- Final approval of the tank asset management plan to the Utility Service Group (USG). Site visits have been completed. A start date and logistics are being outlined for the internal and external refurbishment of Clearwell #2 located at the Lompoc Water Treatment Plant. The Avalon reservoir will be next in the same 26FY to have an external recoat/refurbishment.

Updates for 2026FY:

- Primary CIP for the upcoming FY is the Lime Slaker system replacement. Lynchpin treatment equipment for proper conventional chemical treatment process. Two identical systems to replace the current iteration to allow full redundancy. Estimated cost 1.9 million dollars.
- Continuing forward with finalizing the RFP for the Water Division Master plan development.
- Second phase infrastructure assessment of the WTP.
- Finalizing long term strategic plan for the Frick Springs water system.
