- Informed Commission that as of April Christie Alarcon is no longer with the city and is now the Interim Community Development Director
- A new ADU program will be launched for the community which will offer five options for renovations
- July is National Parks & Recreation month, and all events are listed in the summer activity guide
- Movies in the park are coming up on July 12th & August 2nd at Ryon Park
- Chamber of Commerce finalized agreement and are having Old Town Market starting July 18th through August 8th. They will kick off with the Alumni cruise night and Police Department cruise night/Car show
- Status quo on budget will be receiving a little more funding for parks supplies, new equipment, etc.
- Capital improvement projects there wasn't enough general funding since COVID
- CDBG grant will focus on the stage project, restrooms at Ryon Park and expansion of River Park campgrounds which will generate revenue to invest in future costs
