

**RESOLUTION NO. 6777(25)**

**A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Lompoc,  
County of Santa Barbara, State of California,  
Approving and Authorizing the City of Lompoc to Enter into a  
Settlement Agreements with Opioid Manufacturers Alvogen, Amneal,  
Apotex, Hikma, Indivior, Mylan, Sun, and Zydus (Including the  
Related Combined Participation Agreement) and the Related State  
Subdivision Agreements, and Authorizing the City Manager to Carry  
Out Related Acts**

**WHEREAS**, the United States is facing an ongoing public health crisis of opioid abuse, addiction, overdose, and death, forcing the State of California and California counties and cities to spend billions of dollars each year to address the direct consequences of this crisis; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2024, a proposed settlement was reached in litigation against eight manufacturers (Alvogen, Amneal, Apotex, Hikma, Indivior, Mylan, Sun, and Zydus) (Secondary Manufacturers) related to their contribution to the opioid crisis; and

**WHEREAS**, as part of the settlements with the Secondary Manufacturers, local subdivisions, including certain cities, that are not plaintiffs in the litigation may participate in the settlement in exchange for a release of the Secondary Manufacturers (Participating Subdivision); and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed terms of those nationwide settlements have been set forth in eight settlement agreements, one with each of the Secondary Manufacturers (Secondary Manufacturers Settlement Agreements); and

**WHEREAS**, copies of the Secondary Manufacturers Settlement Agreements have been made available to the City Council with this resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, the Secondary Manufacturers Settlement Agreements provide, among other things, for the payment of a certain sum to settling government entities in California including to the State of California and Participating Subdivisions upon occurrence of certain events as defined in the Settlement Agreements (California Opioid Funds); and

**WHEREAS**, in order to become a Participating Subdivision, the City must enter into a Combined Subdivision Participation and Release Form which allows participation in the Secondary Manufacturers Settlement Agreements; and

**WHEREAS**, California local governments in the litigation have engaged in extensive discussions with the State Attorney General's Office (AGO) as to how the California Opioid Funds will be allocated, which has resulted in the Proposed California State Subdivision Agreements Regarding Distribution and Use of Settlement Funds, one for each of the eight Secondary Manufacturers (State-Subdivision Agreements); and

**WHEREAS**, copies of the eight State-Subdivision Agreements have been made available to the City Council with this resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, under the Secondary Manufacturers Settlement Agreements, certain local subdivisions that did not file a lawsuit against the Secondary Manufacturers may qualify to participate in the settlement and obtain funds from the Abatement Account Fund; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is eligible to participate in the Settlements and become a California Participating Subdivision; and

**WHEREAS**, the intent of this resolution is to authorize the City to enter into the Secondary Manufacturers Settlement Agreements by executing the Combined Participation Agreement and to enter into the State-Subdivision Agreements.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1. Recitals.** The Recitals set forth above are true and correct and are incorporated into this resolution by this reference.

**SECTION 2. Approval and Authorization.** The Secondary Manufacturers Settlement Agreements, Combined Subdivision Participation and Release Form, and California State-Subdivision Agreements are hereby approved, and the City Manager is authorized to execute them.

**SECTION 3. Further Acts.** The City Manager is hereby authorized to carry out all necessary acts such that the City can participate in the Secondary Manufacturers Settlement Agreements, including, without limitation, execution (as necessary) of the Combined Subdivision Participation and Release Form, Secondary Manufacturers Settlement Agreements, State-Subdivision Agreements; and all related documents and the transmittal of thereof.

**SECTION 4. Ratification.** All actions heretofore taken by the City Council and other appropriate public officers and agents of the City with respect to the matters contemplated under this Resolution are hereby ratified, confirmed, and approved.

**SECTION 5. Effective Date.** This Resolution is effective on the day of its adoption.
