

RESOLUTION NO. 6730(25)

**A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Lompoc,
County of Santa Barbara, State of California,
Amending the General Plan Land Use Element to
Implement Housing Element Programs (GP 2024-0003)**

WHEREAS, Text Amendment GP 2024-0003 (Project) to the City of Lompoc's (City) General Plan is for implementation of Housing Element Programs relating to Emergency Shelters, Small Sites, Place-Based Strategies, Affordable Housing Incentives Program and Municipal Code Updates; and

WHEREAS, the City as Lead Agency determined the General Plan amendments is a "Project" under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and an Addendum to the General Plan Final Environmental Impact Report (SCH No. 2008081032) was prepared in conformance with CEQA and the Environmental Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission held a duly-noticed regular public hearing on December 11, 2024, to consider recommendations to the City Council on the General Plan Amendments; and

WHEREAS, on December 11, 2024, the Planning Commission adopted Resolution No. 1015 (24) recommending that the City Council adopt the Amendments to the General Plan Land Use Element and certify the Addendum; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a duly-noticed public hearing on February 4, 2025, to consider the Planning Commission's recommendations and continued the item; and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a duly-noticed public hearing on August 19, 2025, to consider the Planning Commission's recommendations.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The City Council accepts and certifies the Addendum to the General Plan Final Environmental Impact Report (SCH No. 2008081032), as shown in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein, prepared by Rincon Consultants for the General Plan Land Use Element Amendments as required by CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.

SECTION 2: Based upon the testimony provided, the Addendum, and other evidence received at the hearings and staff's written and oral analyses, the City Council finds the proposed Amendments are consistent with State Law and are necessary for the public health and safety.

SECTION 3: The City Council approves the General Plan Land Use Element based on the following findings:

- a) The amendments are internally consistent with all other provisions on the General Plan;
- b) The amendments are internally consistent with any specific plan;
- c) The amendments serve the public necessity, convenience, and general welfare; and
- d) The amendments are in compliance with the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

SECTION 4: The Amendments to the Land Use Element to the City's 2030 General Plan are hereby adopted, as shown in Exhibit B, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

SECTION 5: This Resolution is effective immediately.
