

**RESOLUTION NO. 6784(25)**

**A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Lompoc,  
County of Santa Barbara, State of California,  
Authorizing the City Manager to Execute the Contract Between  
the County of Santa Barbara and the City of Lompoc for the  
Stormwater System Full Trash Capture Project**

**WHEREAS**, the County of Santa Barbara (County) administers the Coastal Resources Mitigation Fund (CRMF), which provides grants to mitigate impacts from offshore oil and gas development on sensitive coastal resources; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Lompoc (City) applied for and was awarded \$42,263 in CRMF funding to support planning and development of the City's Stormwater System Full Trash Capture Project (Project); and

**WHEREAS**, the Project will evaluate storm drain inlets citywide, assess appropriate trash capture technologies, and develop a comprehensive phased implementation plan to reduce pollutants discharged to local waterways and coastal areas; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is required to enter into an agreement with the County of Santa Barbara in order to receive and administer the awarded grant funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to accept the CRMF funding award and authorize the City Manager, or designee, to execute all necessary grant documents, including amendments and assurances, on behalf of the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Council accepts grant funding in the amount of \$42,263 from the County's CRMF to support the Stormwater System Full Trash Capture Project.

**SECTION 2.** The City Council approves the Agreement between the County of Santa Barbara and the City of Lompoc for receipt and administration of the grant.

**SECTION 3.** The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute all CRMF funding-related documents, agreements, amendments, and assurances necessary to effectuate the receipt of the award on behalf of the City of Lompoc.

**SECTION 4.** The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to take any and all actions necessary to implement the intent of this resolution.

**SECTION 5.** Effective Date. This Resolution is effective on the day of its adoption.
