**SUBJECT:** Review of Overnight Recreational Vehicle Parking Ordinance (Lompoc Municipal Code Section 10.28.240)

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### **Recommendation:**

Staff recommends the City Council review Lompoc Municipal Code (LMC) section 10.28.240 concerning Restrictions on Parking of Recreational Vehicles and provide any desired direction to staff.

### **Background:**

LMC section 10.28.240 (attached) prohibits the parking of RVs on all City streets between the hours of 10:00 pm on one day and 6:00 am the next day, unless the owner of the RV obtains a parking permit and parks the vehicle in a permitted location. The ordinance was introduced on July 18, 2023 and adopted on August 15, 2023.

RV permits are available to all City residents and last two years. Residents then must re-apply for a new two-year permit. Residents are able to obtain two-week RV guest permits for their out-of-town guests as well.

A permit allows the RV to park on the same street as the residence listed in the application, within 100 feet of the property line of that residence. If the residence is located on a corner, then the RV may be parked on either of the streets that form the corner, provided the location is also within 100 feet of the property line of the residence.

An RV parking permit does not authorize any vehicle to park in a location or manner that is otherwise prohibited by the LMC or by the California Vehicle Code.

The fee for a two-year RV parking permit is \$55. The fee for a two-week guest RV parking permit is \$55 per permit. Residents are only allowed to have one permit for their own RV, and one guest RV permit at a time. Furthermore, residents are only allowed to obtain a guest RV permit for a total of 60 days in any 12-month period, regardless of the number of guests.

**Discussion:**

The City Council has requested the ordinance be brought to City Council for review and possible action. The City Council may review and discuss the ordinance, ask questions of staff, and provide any desired direction to staff. For example, the City Council may direct staff to return with amendments to the ordinance.

**Fiscal Impact:**

An RV Parking Permit fee of \$55 every two years was established for cost recovery and is posted in the City’s Master Fee Schedule, as indicated Tables 1 and 2 below:
