

RESOLUTION NO. 6787(25)

**A Resolution of the Council of the City of Lompoc
County of Santa Barbara, State of California,
Authorizing the Destruction of Certain Obsolete Records**

WHEREAS, the City of Lompoc (City) has a critical need for storage space and various Divisions and Departments have recently completed an inventory and review of records and have determined certain records are of no further value to the City; and

WHEREAS, Section 34090 of the Government Code of the State of California provides, with the approval of the City Council and the written consent of the City Attorney, the head of a City department may destroy any City record, document, instrument, book or paper under their charge without making a copy thereof, if the same is no longer required; provided that certain records are exempt from the provisions of that Section, as specifically enumerated in that Section; and

WHEREAS, the City Attorney has, in accordance with the provisions of Section 34090 of the Government Code of the State of California, consented in writing to the destruction of the records and documents as set forth herein in Exhibit A attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 6369(20) contains the Records Retention Schedule adopted by the City of Lompoc. All records identified for destruction in Exhibits A and B comport to the Records Retention Schedule and are of sufficient age to be destroyed.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the Management Services Department to destroy those certain records set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and by reference incorporated herein and made part hereof as though fully set forth herein.
