

SECTION 2: This proposal is an adjustment to the City's Sphere of Influence, annexation to the City of Lompoc and detachment of County Service Area 32, the Santa Barbara County Fire Protection District, and the Mosquito and Vector Management District of Santa Barbara County:

SECTION 3: A map of the affected territory is set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein.

SECTION 4: Based on substantial evidence in the record, the City Council does hereby declare that Bailey Avenue Annexation No. 76 ("Boundary Adjustment"):

- A. Conforms with all relevant ^{TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS} policies of the current adopted Lompoc 2030 General Plan.
- B. Adheres to urban limit lines established for the Bailey Avenue Corridor and approved in connection with the 2030 General Plan.
- C. Will have no new or more severe environmental effects beyond what was previously disclosed and considered in connection the GP Update EIR.
- D. ~~Evidences a positive fiscal impact for benefit of both the City and County of Santa Barbara.~~

SECTION 5: Based on the findings and declarations set forth herein, the City Council ~~reclaims its support for the Boundary Adjustment~~ and directs staff as follows:

- A. The City Manager is directed to prepare, execute and submit all required LAFCO application materials and fees relevant to the Boundary Adjustment.
- B. All fees associated with the Boundary Adjustment as prescribed by LAFCO shall be borne by the project proponents. and the City
- C. The foregoing actions shall be accomplished in a ^{REASONABLY} timely manner, and shall ~~affirmatively further the Council's support of the Boundary Adjustment.~~
